Jimmy Peck's leaping goal with three seconds of the overtime left gave Oklahoma its upset victory over Colorado in the first game of the tournament.

It was Oklahoma's second deep freeze which paid off. The Sooners had waited too long in the regulation time when they held the ball for three minutes and twenty-three seconds only to make their move too late to break a 68-all tie.

But the overtime freeze chilled the Buffaloes, favored with Missouri in both the tournament and the conference road lying ahead.

Lane Pushes One In.

Les Lane, who hit thirty-one points for the Sooners, got them an early lead in the overtime with his swishing push shot. Then three free shots were missed by the Sooners as they failed to ice the game.

Colorado's Bob Jeangerard hit Colorado's only goal of the overtime with twenty-nine seconds left to tie it at 71-all.

Oklahoma took the ball downcourt, stalled until six seconds remained, then Lane broke in, passed to Peck and Peck leaped to goal the winner.

Oklahoma, outmanned under the board, fought Colorado ferociously throughout. The Buffs
