KANSAS CITY, MO. — Kansas State couldn't contain the individual brilliance of forward Don Weber here Monday night as Nebraska pulled a huge 78-74 basketball upset.

Weber, a 6-foot 3-inch senior from Estherville, Ia., furnished 30 points—24 of them in the second half—to knock the defending champion Wildcats out of Big Seven tournament title play.

In the night's second game Oklahoma downed Washington, the guest team, 87-77, in a contest that was a 42-42 standoff at halftime. The Sooners' Lester Lane scored 28 points.

It is the first time in the eight-year history of the meet that Kansas State hasn't won its first test, and the Weber-led assault that destroyed the 'Cats had 8,500 people highly excited.
