dec. 31... oklahoma placed one man, forward sherman norton, on the sixth annual big seven tournament all-star team, released here monday after a vote of sportswriters and sportscasters.

the hawk-faced sharpshooter, who established two new tourney records, earned a slot on the second team along with jim ramstead, stanford center; win wilfong, sensational missouri freshman, and kansas state's jack carby and dick knostman.

norton electrified a near-sellout house in thursday night's first round when he rolled home 39 points..... 16 of them on wide-open crips out of the now famed "Bruce Drake Shuffle " for a new single game point mark.

this was the big wallop in ushering the sooners past stanford, 77-71, in what proved to be the only genuine upset of the meet. the former record of 38 was erected by minnesota's maynard johnson just last year.

sherman's second mark was a string of 22 21 consecutive free throws, which he put together through the first two games. he tied bob peterson's three-year-old standard in one game alone, natching 13 straight against stanford. he added seven more as ou went down before missouri in the semifinals, then chuffed his second attempt in the third-place playoff with kansas state.
