My dear Miss Lear:

I want to thank you very much for the list of varsity basketball players that you have checked for eligibility. I am sending also a list of freshmen basketball players, and I would appreciate your checking their grades.

My purpose in asking for the freshmen is to write a letter to each faculty member who has students in class who are doing either unsatisfactory or failing work. The varsity and freshmen play a game Friday night in the auditorium. I do not propose to play any varsity or freshman men in this game who have failing work at the present time, even though they are eligible to play in this game.

So far as the varsity players are concerned, they would be eligible if they have had 27 hours the two preceding semesters, even though some of their work now might be unsatisfactory, but I am anxious to play the game with the faculty members, showing them that I will not use any players unless all their work is at least satisfactory.

I will appreciate your early cooperation in getting this list of freshmen to me so that I may announce the starting and eligible line-up.

I have just checked over your grades with the college Office and I find that you have the following low grades:

According to Kansas basketball tradition, all those making failing grades must check in their suits until their work is brought up to Satisfactory. For those making D grades or Unsatisfactory grades there is a probationary period of one week until those grades can be brought up to Satisfactory.

However, no player is permitted to participate in Kansas basketball varsity and freshman competition while their work is listed as Unsatisfactory. Therefore, it will be necessary for you to see your instructors and satisfy them as to your Unsatisfactory and failing grades. Unless a letter is produced from the teachers stating that your work is satisfactory, you will not be permitted to participate or even to practice basketball until this work is brought up.

I will be glad to see you make progress toward your academic work.


