Dear Phog:

On my return to New York I checked on the transportation costs between Kansas City and New York. The round trip rate rail fare is \$69.05. The pullman would be approximately \$15.00 round trip, or \$85.00 a person, which would total \$1275 for a party of fifteen. I presume that you will be away from the campus approximately six days, and on the basis of \$100 a day for your party - to cover meals and hotel accommodations - I would say that a total of \$1850 would be about the right estimate.



If this figure seems a fair estimate to you of your probable expenses for the trip, I will be glad to pass the information along to Fordham and Temple, so that they can cover this amount in the agreements to be executed by them with Kansas. I would like to suggest that of the \$1850 total, \$1500 would be reimbursed you by Fordham for participation in basketball here and the balance of \$350 to be reimbursed to you by Temple.

If this arrangement is satisfactory to you, I will immediately communicate with Fordham and Temple, so that they have a clear understanding of this picture.
