Dear Mr. Evans:

Dr. Allen will be glad to come but with gas and tire rationing could not drive. If train connections are such at that time so that he could get out of here at noon and get to Miltonvale by train or bus and back here the next day by early afternoon, he will come for \$25. gross. He takes care of necessary expenses.

If such arrangements are not possible, he would leave here on noon train and let you pick him up at Junction City, Solomon, or Salina that afternoon and then get him back to the Union Pacific someplace so that he could get the train that leaves Salina at 10:30 A.M. The fee in this case would be the same except that you would have the added cost of the necessary transportation to and from the places on Union Pacific where you pick him up.
