Mr. Harry Darby, Vice-president and Director of the Navy League of the United States has asked me to serve as Navy Day Chairman for the state of Kansas this year. You have been recommended to serve as Chairman for your County and I hope you will be in a position to accept this responsibility. October 27 is Navy Day. It was chosen as the date for the observance of Navy Day because it marks the anniversary of the date in 1775 when the Continental Congress received the bill providing for the creation of an independent fleet.
