portrayal of Farmer Link Squires. You will note the film opens with Brennan on his farm where he receives a fantastic visit from a man. At first this little man appears to be a seed salesman.

Later it develops he is a representative of right eating. Actually, this is merely a hallucination or dream on the part of Link.

As you will see, Link is really telling his story in court where he has been brought on various charges, including disturbing the peace because of his too-fervent campaign for good nutrition. It is well to keep in mind that this film was made with this entertaining theme to make it more receptive. Already more than five million American theatergoers have seen "Hidden Hunger."

The film, undoubtedly, has done much to arouse interest in good nutrition.
