KOON RETAINS PERFECT FREE THROW RECORD

THE BOB HOUBREGS BOX SCORE

Unstopable Bob Houbregs boosted his all-time Northern Division record total to five over the weekend as the Husky scoring ace shattered two marks in Washington's twin victories over Washington State. Despite the keen defensive set-up devised of Goach Jack Friel of the Cougars and the exceptional defensive work of center Pill Render, Big Bob broke loose for 49 points in the series. His feats for the weekend include:

- 1. A new Northern Division scoring record of 276 points with six games yet to play. This new high breaks the former total of 265 points held by Jack Nichols of Washington in 1948.
- 2. Total field goals for the season of 103 in ND play, bettering the former standard of 98 set by WSC's Vince Hanson in 1945.
- Clearing the boards for a weekend total of 30 rebounds. Big Bob gathered in 13 rebounds Friday night with 11 of them coming in the first quarter. He now has 72 rebounds in the last five games to his credite

Charlie Koon continued his reliable ways from the free throw line against the Cougars by hitting four free throws in four attempts. Charlie sank a pair of free tosses each night to raise his unblemished record to 16 straight in Northern Division play. His season mark stands at 41 in 46 attempts for a percentage of 691.
