

take the teaching methods course and supervised teaching in their major subject, or in their minor. Students in the School of Education will elect one additional hour of Education courses; students in other schools of the University will elect three hours.

Advanced Teachers Diploma requirements include, in addition to the Education courses listed above: General Psychology, 3 hours; Social Studies, 3 hours; Fundamentals of Speech, 2 hours, a major, and a minor.

This diploma qualifies the holder for a license (non-renewable-for-life certificate) for teaching at the secondary level or below, with certificate being issued by the State Board of Education upon application.
