For all practical purposes many intercollegiate conferences could be divided into a "big pocketbook league" and a "small pocketbook League". The "big pocketbook league" members are generally the championship winners, and the "small pocketbook league" members are the consolation winners.

This high commissioner would have authority to remove any commissioner of any conference who did not enforce the law. Of necessity this high commissioner would be a man the type of Judge Landis. The Black Sox scandal imperiled the reputation and confidence of professional baseball. By wise administration and fearless action Judge Landis has again rebuilt confidence in the game. A great and fearless character in this high office could again stabilize this magnificent sport and again create a confidence in America's greatest college game.
