The quintet, all regulars except Pearlstein, already have been dropped from the basketball squad. Further action by the school will be taken tomorrow when the faculty-student athletic committee convenes. Leder is a member of the committee and also head of the College Men's Athletic association.

May Amend Penal Code.

The state law, as it now reads, makes it a felony to bribe a professional athlete but a bill amending the penal code so that amateur sports and athletes may be covered was offered in the legislature today.

Manhattan police disclosed that since horse racing came to an end on Jan. 3 more than a dozen men have been arrested in connection with bookmaking on sports events in the Garden.

Led by Dr. Forrest [Phog] Allen, the veteran University of Kansas basketball coach, sports officials asked that something be done quickly to curb gambling.

Ned Irish, acting president of the Garden, and metropolitan athletic heads, took undisclosed steps to curb gambling and protect players from approaches by persons interested in influencing the outcome of games.
