Dear William:

I have your letter of the twenty-eighth and beg your pardon for not answering sooner. We have no scholarships at the University of Kansas. We have jobs that pay 50¢ an hour but we are not as highly organized athletically as some institutions.

We have some fine teams but they do not border on the so called big time. Someone asked us this morning for a record of our basketball games and in compiling it we discovered that we have won some nineteen out of twenty-eight of the Missouri Valley and Big Six Championship in the indoor games.

Our schedule includes ten games in the Big Six Conference and we generally play the top teams in the other conferences. We have a wonderful School of Business here at the University. I feel quite certain when I say that a degree from this School of Business is on a par with the best in the country.
