
Dear Phog:

I have your letter of January 26, and I presume that the alumni loan fund refers to the plan for loans to students as arranged by Mr. Ellsworth with the various K. U. alumni organizations.

I wonder if you would care to mention the men's residence halls and the way they are operated. I am enclosing a circular about them which may help you. This type of thing seems to make a general appeal, especially when one hears about boys cooking their own food--for example, roasts, pastries, etc., and doing a good job of it. The total cost last year was \$13.90 per man per month for room, board, and everything. The boys make their own beds, clean house, etc.

I cannot think of anything else at this time, but if I do get an idea, I will let you know.
