Subj: Comprehensive Achievement Test for V-12 Students.

- 1. On 21 July 1944 a Comprehensive Achievement Test will be given to all V-12 students who, by 1 November 1944, will have completed two (2) (and only two) terms of college work, including any taken prior to entry into the V-12 program.
