EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 21-44

From: Executive Officer.
To : All V-12 Trainees.

Subj. LEAVE.

1. Trainees may apply for leave beginning after their last scheduled duty for the term. They may pick up leave papers when they can present chits showing all their books and blankets have been turned in. Trainees may not request special exams from the faculty to enable them to have longer leaves.
2. Trainees not being transferred may apply for leave end at 0600 Monday, 3 July 1944. Pre-Medics who have pre-enrolled may apply for leave ending at 2400, 3 July 1944.
3. Trainees who are being screened may travel at their own expense to be reimbursed at their next duty station, thus avoiding a return to Lawrence to pick up orders. In general, "screenings" should expect to report at their new station on 3 July 1944. Trainees who wish this arrangement should report to Chief Yeoman Conte at once.
4. Trainees going to Midshipman's School will travel on individual orders, to report at various specified dates.
5. Trainees, who flunk out, will be notified of their status on their return from leave and will be separated then.
6. New men will report aboard before trainees on leave return. Those on leave should secure personal gear before going away.
7. Trainees wishing ration certificates should apply at the V-12 Office promptly. They should not apply to local ration boards.
