EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 26-44

THE FOLLOWING NAMED MEN HAVE BEEN PLACED ON ACADEMIC RESTRICTION FOR PERIOD ENDING 1 JULY 1944. THEY SHOULD SURRENDER THEIR LIBERTY CARDS AT THE V-12 OFFICE BY 1200 WEDNESDAY 12 JULY 1944.

WHILE ON ACADEMIC RESTRICTION, THESE MEN WILL ENGAGE IN NO EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES. THEY WILL BE ON STATION BOUNDS EXCEPT FOR THE AFTERNOON RECREA-HOUR, 1630-1730, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, AND FROM 1330 SATURDAY TO 1530 SUNDAY.

IF TRAINEES, ON RESTRICTION, WISH TO LEAVE LAWRENCE SATURDAY NIGHT, THEY MUST APPLY TO THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER FOR THEIR LIBERTY CARDS.
