EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S ORDER NO. 52-44

Subj: PT-1 for Seventh V-12 Term - Scheduling of.

1. With few exceptions, the quotas for V-12 Units for the 1 July 1945 term will include a considerable number of first-year, first-term students. These trainees will be scheduled for PT-1, the basic physical training program.
2. Now that most of the Units have only two specialists (A) on board, it is important that the basic physical training sections be scheduled at different class hours from the maintenance training sections.
3. It is suggested that the necessity for the separation of basic and maintenance groups be called to the attention of the college scheduling officers in order that this may be considered in drawing up over-all schedules.
4. The importance of scheduling physical training as an integral part of the total schedule should be emphasized. A satisfactory physical training schedule cannot be superimposed on an academic schedule which has already been laid out. At many Units it will be possible to construct the entire schedules for the new trainees in solid groups of twenty (20) to thirty (30) each.

Subj: Physical Training Classes

The following weekly schedule is recommended for all physical training classes:

1. Monday, Wednesday and Friday classes:
 - (a) When weather permits:
 1. Outside calisthenics
 2. Outside Obstacle course
 3. Outside running (relays, etc.)
 - (b) During wet weather:
 1. Inside Calisthenics
 2. Inside Obstacle course (apparatus room) parallel bars, climbing ropes, overhead ladders, etc.
 3. Tumbling
2. Tuesday and Thursday classes
 - (a) Outside when weather permits:
 1. Calisthenics
 2. Games - softball, soccer, touch football, handball, badminton.
 - (b) During wet weather
 1. Games - Volleyball, basketball, badminton, handball, boxing or bag punching.
3. All classes except swimming are to be preceded with six to eight minutes strenuous calisthenics.
4. Closer supervision is emphasized.
