I have your letter of June 30th requesting some information on the teaching of basketball, and regret that I am unable to send you any material for teacher in Chile.

"My Basketball Bible", to which you refer, has been out of print for several years. I have a much later text, "Better Basketball", published by the McGraw-Hill Publishing Company of New York City, which I am sure would be very valuable to this Chilean instructor. It was written particularly for the coach, is fully illustrated with diagrams and photographs, and describes fully the fundamentals of the game. I am enclosing some printed material which will show you something of the contents of the book. The text sells for \$4.00, and may be purchased at most of the leading sporting goods firms.

My only other suggestion would be some of the magazines for coaches, such as "The Scholastic Coach", 220 E. 42nd St., New York City, and "Athletic Journal", 6858 Glenwood Ave., Chicago, Illinois. If I come across anything that I think will be of assistance to you I shall send it along.
