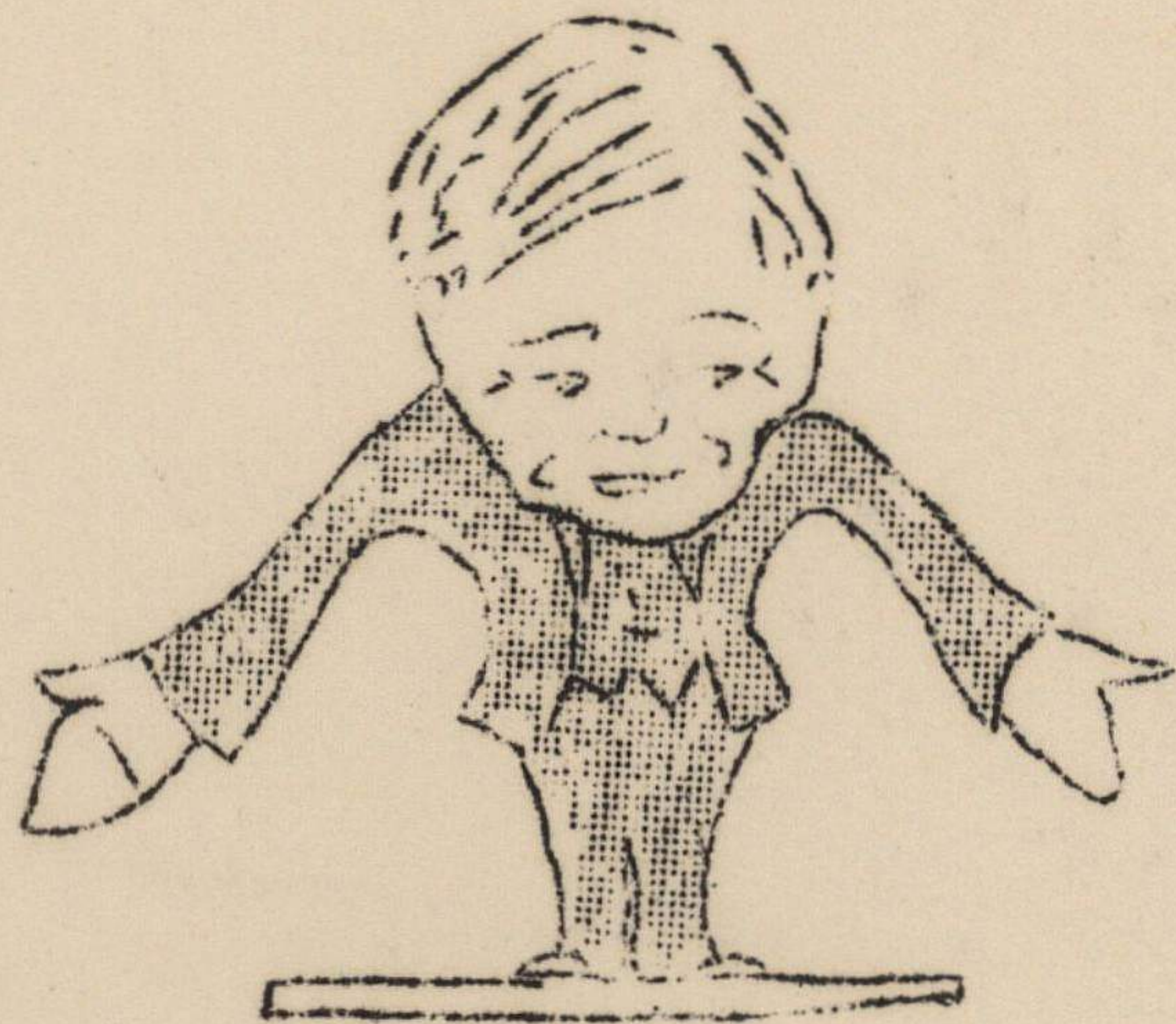

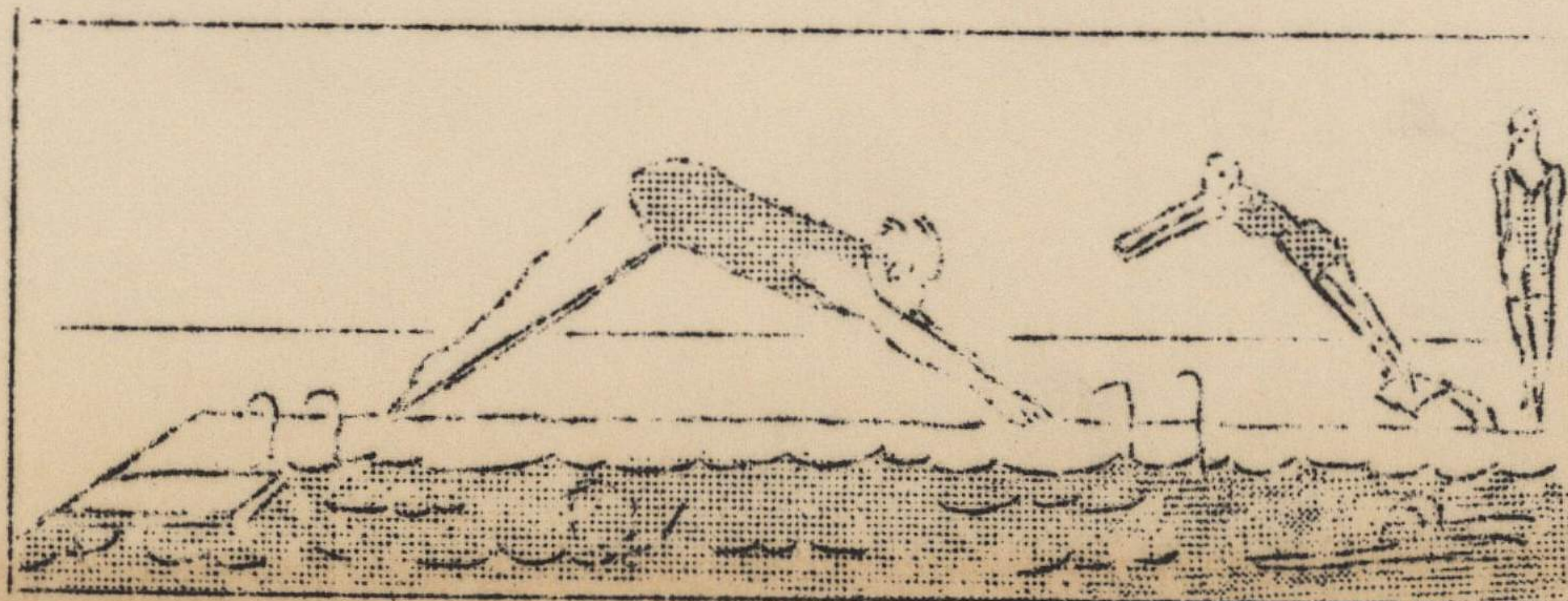

Dear Dr. Allen:


I am enclosing a copy of the preliminary announcement that is being made with regard to the Conference on Public Swimming Pools to be held April 21 and 22.
