INTRODUCTION

The following is a report of the material presented at the First Illinois Swimming Pool Conference:

This conference, the first of its kind to be held in this State, was sponsored by the State Department of Public Health in cooperation with the University of Illinois Physical Education Department. It is an outgrowth of small sectional meetings of swimming pool operators which have been held throughout the State for the past two years as part of the State Department of Public Health's swimming pool program.
