HEISMAN TROPHY PRESENTATION CEREMONIES POSTPONED

It has been necessary to postpone the 11th Annual Heisman Trophy Award Ceremony and dinner at the Downtown Athletic Club scheduled for Tuesday evening, December 11, 1945, due to the conflict with examinations at West Point which prevents the winner, Felix (Doc) Blanchard, from being present at the Club.

The Heisman Trophy Committee regret very deeply that this postponement is necessary. A special committee conferred with General Taylor at West Point today and it has been arranged that the award ceremonies will be held at the Club on Saturday evening, January 5, 1946.

President Wottrich has asked me to advise you of the change in date to January 5, 1946 and to express the hope that you will be our guests on that occasion. The committee is proceeding with its original program and more than 800 reservations indicate that this will be one of the most successful Heisman parties.
