Dear Mr. Allen:

Like many other people I am now out of the army and want to return to college. However I have a wife and baby and I realize it will be very difficult to make it, but I am willing to work hard.

I have the \$75 a month from the government to go to school, but I need another job. At most schools now, living space is limited and with my family that is another problem.

I played high school football and basketball at Arkansas City, Kansas and the coach here, Mr. Micholson, said I should give his name as reference. My senior year was at Westport High School in Kansas City, Mo. Reference there are the coaches, Mr. G.V. Bourrettee and Mr. Gayle Chubb.

I just turned 21 last September. I am 5' 11" and weigh 195 lbs. Which is about 10 pounds too heavy, but I will lose it.

I lettered in basketball at Rockhurst College in Kansas City, Mo. I played only three or four games after the semester before going to the army. So I am still a freshman. Mr. Nicholson spoke of some war ruling by which I may have used only one semester's eligibility. He was not certain of this, however.

I played both forward and guard positions, but most of the time I played forward.

I believe I've gotten the entire situation down now. If you could use me or have any suggestions I'd appreciate them.
