It was a pleasure indeed to hear that you are to be with us next Thursday evening for our banquet honoring the football and basketball squads.

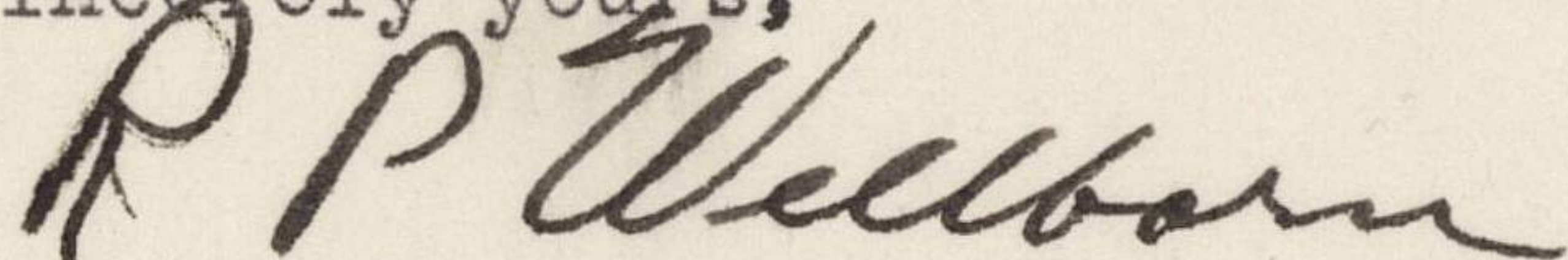
