A special stockholders meeting is to be held at the club house for the purpose of amending Section Three of Article Six of the By-Laws relative to dues for social members, and to transact any other business pertinent to stockholders. The proposed wording of Section Three, Article Six reads as follows:

"The dues for social members shall be \$20. per year payable six months in advance. One-fourth of all such dues collected shall be placed in a special fund to be expended solely for the purpose of retiring the mortgage indebtedness of the Club."

"The dues for Class One non-resident members shall be \$36. per year, payable in twelve monthly installments due the first of each month, in advance. One-sixth of all such dues collected shall be placed in a special fund to be expended solely for the purpose of retiring the mortgage indebtedness of the club."
