Dear Mr. Weems:

Acknowledging your letter of February 7th, I will answer your questions in order.

Yes, our basketball games are played directly upon our permanent auditorium floor. Should you desire to employ a false floor, I suggest that you write to Dean John W. Bunn, at Stanford University, Stanford, California. He can give you the arrangement of the false floor in Madison Square Garden, New York. I have seen the floor in operation, but I believe that Mr. Bunn could give you more definite information on it.

There are two standard slide-proof surfaces that I definitely know of - the Hillyard Chemical Company, St. Joseph, Missouri, and the Seal-O-San Company, of Huntington, Indiana. By writing to these people I am sure they would be glad to send you information on their compositions. Madison Square Garden uses the Hillyard product, and a number of colleges and universities use the Seal-O-San floor finish. Both are standard.
