Knack-----We've been calling you Doctor Allen, Doc and Phog--where does that nickname of Phog come in?

Allen ----

Knack-----So that's it. If they call you Phog I wonder what they ought to call Quigley?

Mehl-----Joe, that's where Quigley and Allen form a team. Dr. is called Phog and Quigley has been called everything else.

Knad -----Phog, I'm going to knock you over with this question. Who will win the Big Six basket ball race this season? And I want the truth.

Allen ----

Mehl ---- thought you asked him for the truth, Joe?

Knack----I did and he answered the truth as well as he could. You see, there's different truths. One for the average man and one for the coach.

Mehl-----Dhog, tell us, do you make those predictions with your tongue in your cheek?

Allen----

Knack----Apparently, Phog, psychology plays an important factor in coaching, doesn't it? Suppose we try out that psychology here.

We'll imagine the game is one with three minutes left to play. Your team is three points behind. I'm a substitute on the bench. How would you send me in the game?
