



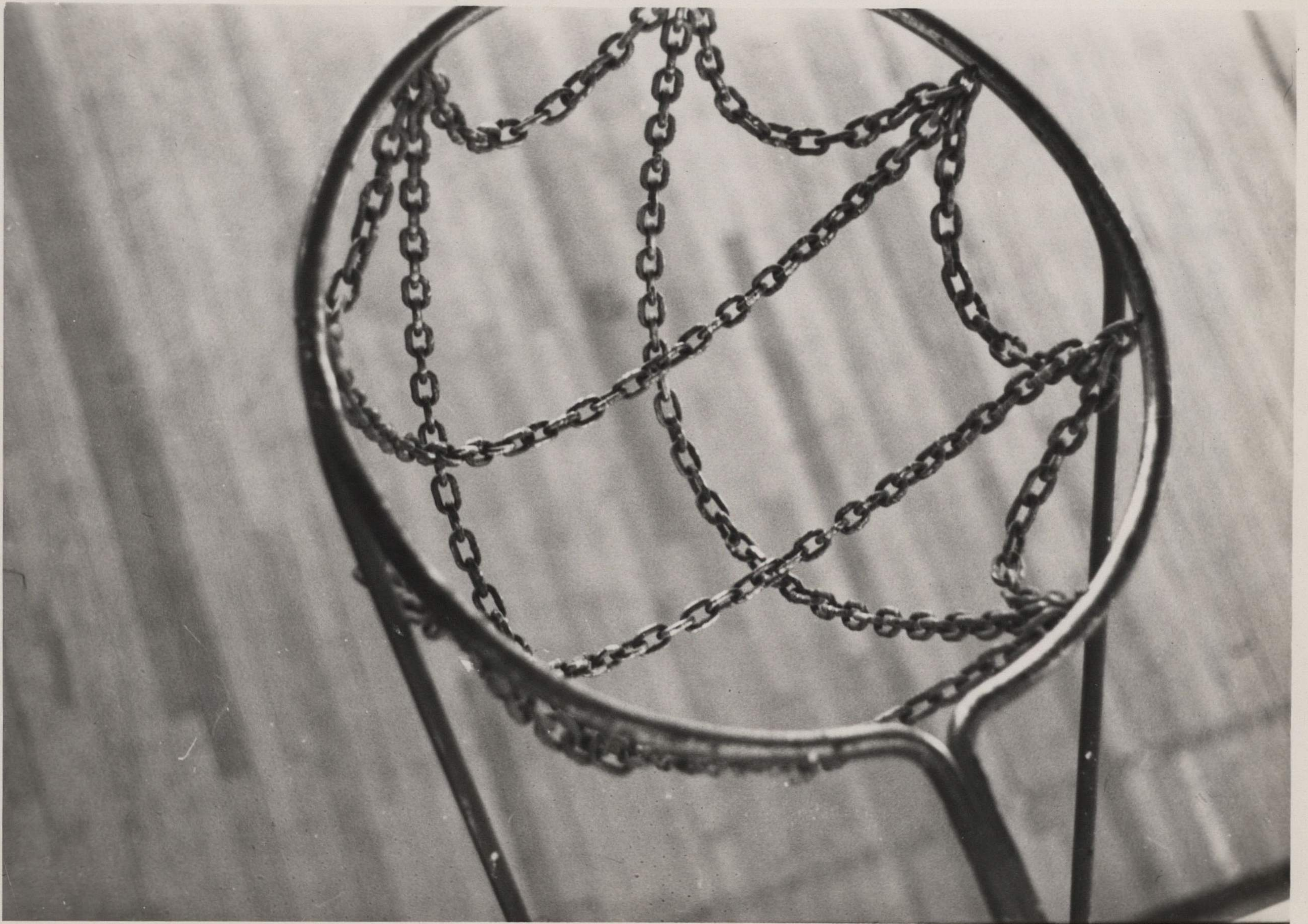

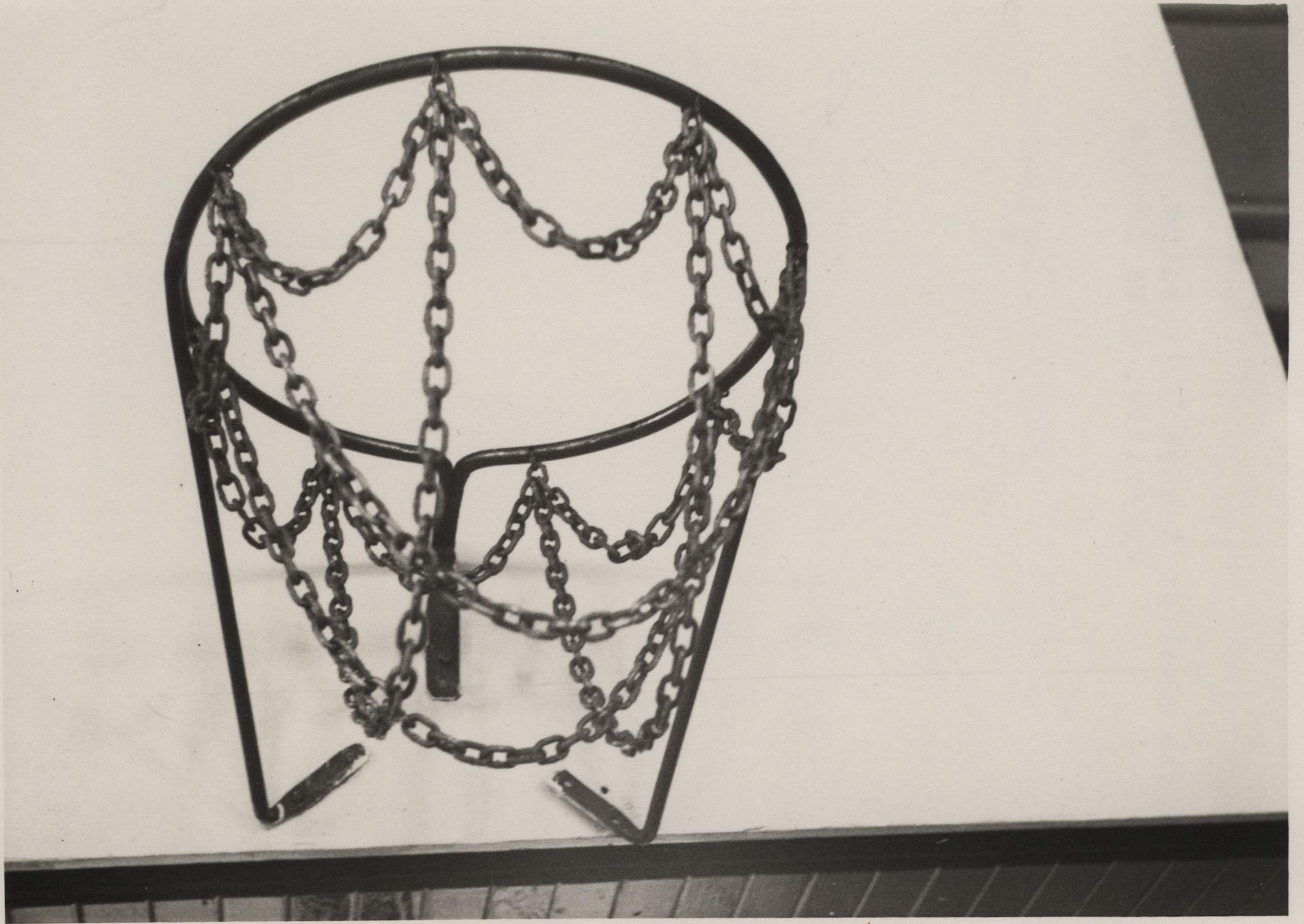

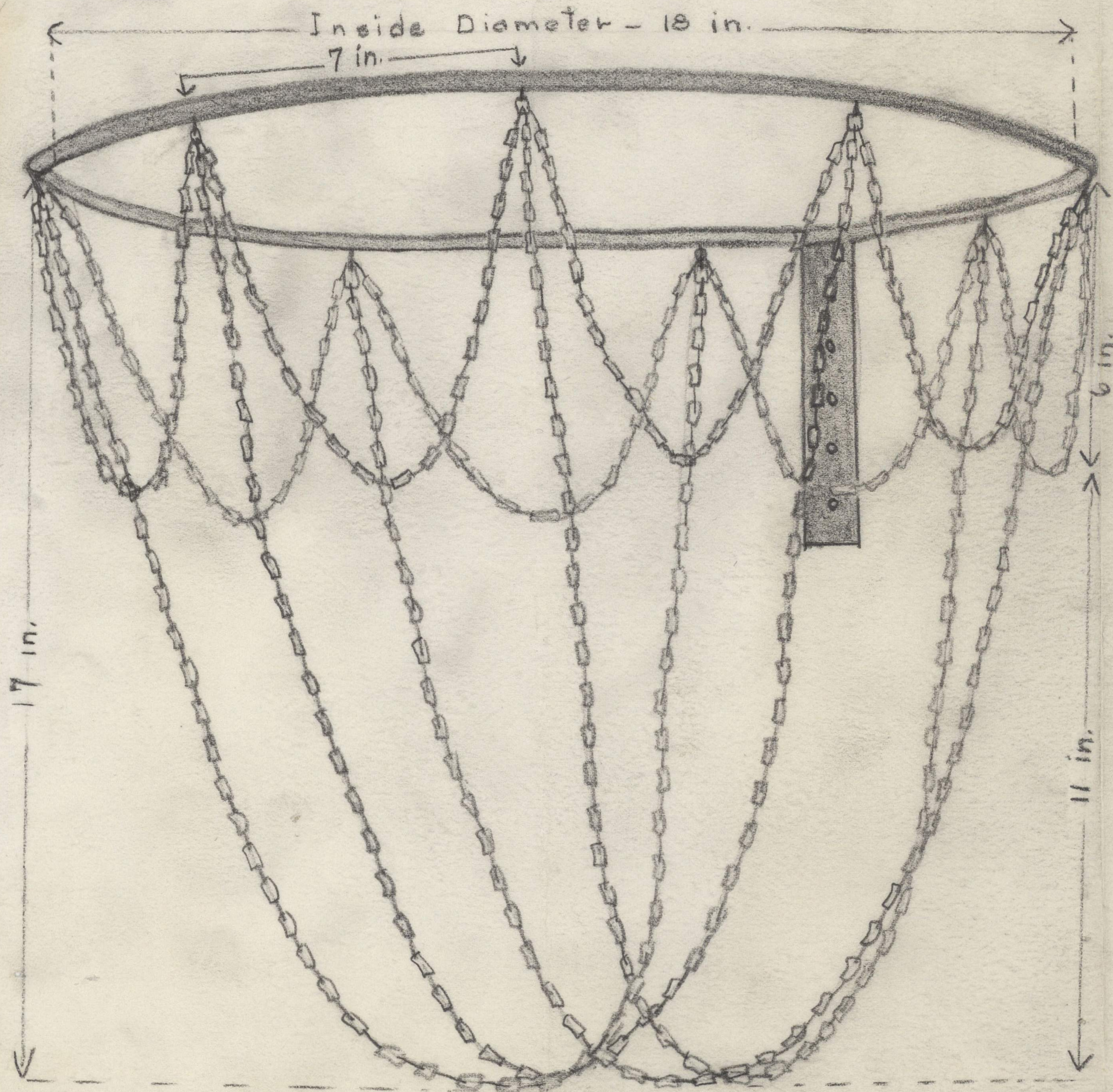

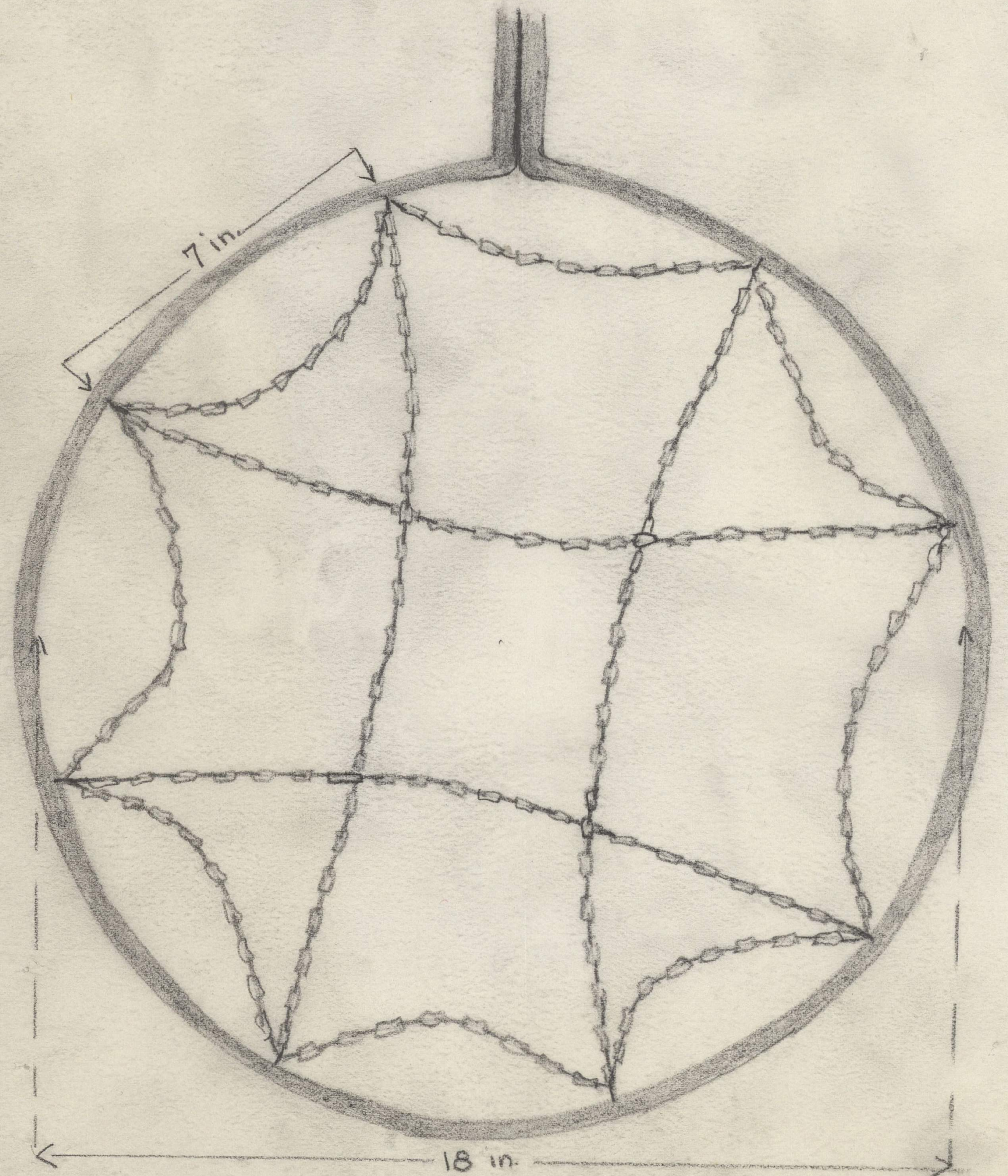

Dear Mr. Tower:

I am enclosing a drawing of a basket that we have been using here at Acadia for a number of years. It originated here and has been in constant use with most satisfactory results. It has these advantages:

- 1.--made of chain-- therefore is indestructable-- never out of order such as the nets that constantly wear out and need repairing.
2. makes the basket very stable.
3. against the white backboard- gives the player a vision of rather a large basket.
4. never any mistake about a basket being made-- there is a slight pause of the ball as it goes thru-- chains slide apart and ball drops.
