

On the playground we move these from place to place to keep from killing the grass. It would be necessary to make holes and put in posts for these games, such as badminton, aerial darts, and volley ball, if we did not have this portable equipment. But it would be impossible to build anything in the gymnasium unless we made cuts into the floor and put steel keepers there. This would render a very definite hazard to the students and would produce many accidents and injuries.

The purpose, as I understand it, of this rubber salvage is not to take anything that is in use, but to take worn out, unused and outmoded rubber equipment. Certainly to take this would be contributing to a definite loss. It would take ten times the worth of the rubber to provide for us these very necessary play utilities.
