Memo to the Chancellor:

After talking with Fred Montgomery, I talked with Captain Buhl, and the only place that is available for the personnel of the Navy is the field known as the Spencer Field. Although it means knocking out some of the important intramural games on Saturday morning, we have made arrangements so that the Navy may use the field from 9 to 11:15 on Saturday mornings.

This large area provides space for four intramural games to be played at one time, and it is a heavy blow to the intramural schedule on Saturday mornings. But in our language service requirements come first, and Captain Buhl has been assured that each Saturday he will have the field for this time.
