Dear Chancellor Malott:

Replying to the carbon copy of Dr. Canuteson's letter of May 20th, I wish to say that it was our thought from the beginning to have the horse show in the pasture south of the campus where Mr. Bayles pastures the horses used in his department. I had talked to Mr. Bayles about this, and secured his permission to use this space for the horse show.

I share Dr. Canuteson's concern about the danger of tetanus infection, but we had no notion of using the intramural playing field for the horses. Dr. Canuteson told me that he read in the Kansan that the horse show was to be on the intramural field, but this was an error. We had previously made arrangements with Mr. Bayles to use the pasture.
