



committee. My letter to Mr. Olsen dated September 27 and Mr. J.W. St. Clair's letter dated September 30 will restate our position.

You will recall that Missouri, Oklahoma and Kansas made \$1,000 net after our expenses were paid in Wichita at the Big Six play-off. The Fifth District play-off between the Oklahoma Aggies and Kansas at Oklahoma City netted an additional \$1,000 to Oklahoma and Kansas each, after expenses were paid. The crux of the whole thing is that the N.C.A.A. Executive Committee is taking the financial plum from the gate receipts when the great crowds assembled in Kansas City for the Western and the National play-offs.

This report is merely for your information and your office records. The early material enclosed is to show you the metamorphosis of the tournament.
