Confirming our conversation this morning, we shall be very happy to have Mr. A. E. Bagley speak to our Physical Education students here at the University.

Since talking with you, two things have occurred to me which might be of interest in planning his program. I think it would be splendid if Mr. Bagley could speak to the Sasnak Club, composed of majors in the Department of Physical Education.
