I acknowledge receipt of your good letter this morning. I find that you are slightly mixed on the schedule, as Kansas plays Iowa State College on October 16, and Kansas State College on November 13.

However, I immediately got in conference with Mr. Earl Falkenstien, the financial secretary of the Athletic Association, who handles the ticket sale, and he is following your directions regarding sending the tickets and so forth, with the thought that you perhaps wanted the Iowa State tickets instead of Kansas State. If you really prefer Kansas State it will be an easy matter to send them back and get the Kansas State tickets later.

I am enclosing a football schedule for your convenience. There is one correction on it - the "B" team game with the Missouri "B" team has been cancelled. Coach Lindsey did not want to risk his reserves against Missouri on October 22 when all will be needed for the fracas at Norman when they meet the University of Oklahoma on October 23.

You certainly are not unreasonable in asking for your K ticket and your Relays ticket. You paid for your Relays ticket, and your K ticket is an honor award that you won many years ago.
