Dear Mr. Davidson,

Some time along in the summer I wrote you and I also spoke to you regarding the painting of the handball courts. I was sure that you understood that I wanted them repaired where they needed it.

There are some loose boards, and on the west handball courts the lights need fixing. I believe we also spoke to you about painting the side walls to the height of seven feet clear around.
