Dear Sir:

I believe you have the solution for the extremely tall center - restraining circle under goal + no tip in shots. The tall man still has ~~no~~ sporting advantage - but not an impossible advantage as now.

I'd also like to see the rules revised in two other items: first all tie balls should be thrown from ^{one of} three circles - center or free throw circles. Secondly - the team throwing a free throw should not be penalized by losing the ball, but should be given the ball out of bounds near center. Otherwise a team 2 ahead can foul without being penalized during last 30 seconds - in fact can foul to advantage as it merely loses possession of ball (option assumed) where it may not have had possession to begin with.

To illustrate: team a - 2 pts ahead last 30 seconds O = team a
X = team B
