Dear Mr. Noland:

We have just learned that it is barely possible that your Dartmouth College basketball team will go through our college town enroute to San Francisco.

If you should decide on your itinerary routing you through this section I would be very happy to offer you the services of our University of Kansas court for practice.

Lawrence is 42 miles west of Kansas City on the main trunk lines of the Santa Fe, Rock Island and Union Pacific. It is less than an hour's run from Kansas City, and the train connections are very splendid.

The University of Kansas is playing the University of Texas on December 16 and 17 at Austin, and Southern Methodist University on December 19 and 20 at Dallas.

I am quite sure that you would want nothing but a light work-out with your own group participating. Our Big Six Conference rules prohibit our working against opponents in any practice game unless it is counted a regular game competition. We are limited to a twenty game schedule during the season. I only mention this to emphasize the fact that we are inviting you to use our quarters at your own discretion.

Should you desire to stop in Kansas City there are a number of regulation courts that could be obtained there, and we would be glad to be of any service to you and your Coach Cowles.
