identification. I am sending you, herewith, a picture of the dedication of Broadgate and some others and also a copy of a letter from the Superintendent of the Foxhill nursery concerning one of the children who will give your people an idea of the type of children in the nurseries. Billy Connolly is sponsored by one of your Kansas women but he is only an example of what is true at Broadgate or elsewhere.

Professor Mix advises that he does not know just what support will be secured from your local War Fund. I should think that it would be a matter of first consideration as one of the few distinctly Kansas projects in Ingland where your name is clearly identified and which is welcomed by the British to be continued.
