member of the student body are elected by the student body.

This election serves as a nomination to the U. of Ks. P.E.C.
The corporation elects ~~two~~ ^{three} members to their board.
The ~~two student~~ ^{two} ~~members~~ ^{are} also elected to the U. of Ks. P.E.C.

The Alumnus also elects their four members and
that election serves as a nomination to the Corporation. The
four alumni members who hold membership under this

Chancellor Lindley is an officer member of the Board.
The eligibility for the athletes participation of all
athletes is set by the Missouri Valley Conf. etc. or

The faculty representatives are the legislative body
of the conf. making all laws and rules governing participation of
