The University of Kansas Physical Education Corporation, otherwise known as the Athletic Board of the University, is a non-profit-sharing corporation of fourteen members, eight of whom are faculty members which control the finances and direct the intercollegiate policy of the University of Kansas.

The eight faculty members of the University of Kansas Physical Education Corporation (Athletic Board) are:

These members, with the exception of Chancellor Lindley and Mr. Klooz, are nominated by the University Senate.

There are also two student members - the president of the Men's Student Council, Don Voorhees, and one athletic member of the student body, Ferrell Anderson, elected by the student body. This election serves as a nomination to the University of Kansas Physical Education Corporation. The Corporation proceeds to elect these two student members to their board.

The Alumni Association also elects their four members, and that election serves as a nomination to the Corporation. The four alumni members who hold membership under this plan are:
