Strate Dear Friends: Mr. Shenk and I have discussed the possibility of the ineffectiveness of the rule whereby the Exemption Committee may expel a student from the University when he has six cuts. I suggest that we have a meeting on our way to Lincoln to discuss the thing, as well as the clarification of the grading system that is, what is possible for an A, for a B, for a C, etc. Then I believe we should suggest to the Chancellor and the administrative committee the possibility of penalizing the student one hour when he has six outs, or possible expulsion from the University for insubordination in not attending classes. If we could have a fulsome discussion of this with an idea of a recommendation being made to the administration for the next squester to take the place of the hastily planned scheme of things as in operation now, I believe it would be very helpful.
