The following three enrollments in physical education for the spring semester should be cleared up. (1) Robert Martindell was enrolled in physical education in the 7:30 class for no credit. The grade sheet does not show his name, and therefore no grade was turned in nor did he withdraw. His name did not appear on the correction sheet which was sent to your department before the grade sheets were made out. (2) William Shaw was enrolled in the 10:30 class for one hour credit. He did not withdraw, but your grade sheet shows him as withdrawn. (3) George R. Ware was enrolled in the 10:30 Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday class for one hour credit. The grade sheet does not bear his name, nor did your correction sheet show it. He did not withdraw.

According to our rules, each of these three should receive a failure, for none of them withdrew after enrolling in the classes. The question is should these three failures be given because of the student's carelessness even though the department did not do its part in getting these cases straightened out at the proper time and in the proper way.
