
There seems to be some question regarding the physical education grade of Malcolm J. Brumwell for the fall semester of 1935.

The situation is this: He took 3a Elementary Swimming the first half, and made a "B"; he took 3b Intermediate Swimming the second half, but after about two weeks developed sinus trouble, and was advised not to take swimming; 15a Elementary Boxing came at the same hour, and it is my opinion that we received Dean Lawson's permission to shift him to the boxing class. The records show that Brumwell made a "B" in boxing. He received a grade in Health Instruction of "B", which made an average of "B".

I think the big question is this - did Brumwell take the boxing course for which he received a grade. He did.
