Dear Director Allen:


I am sorry to have been a little slow in looking up  
Dave Shirk and his x-rays.

I saw him on March 1st., 1938 and he stated then that in  
July, 1937 he did a back flip dive and injured his foot which became  
swollen and uncomfortable and had had a little trouble since.

On examination at that time I was not able to account for  
the pain he complained of in the region of the right great toe joint  
as the physical examination was negative as were the x-ray findings.

I furnished him with an anterior arch pad, told him that  
I did not see any contraindication to his playing football and if he  
had any further trouble to let me know and I have not heard from him  
since, so hope he is all right.
