In part (A) of Table III one may read that 146 teachers of English received an average (median) salary of \$172.00 per month; and that three-fourths of the number were paid \$159.00 or more, while one-fourth had a monthly salary of \$184.00 or more. The median of all teachers (1083) in these schools was \$179.00, Community high schools and the new school system called Plainview are also included in this part of TableIII.
