Dear Dean Smith:

I appreciate your speaking to me about the towel cards which the towel room attendant told you could not be used the second semester.

This regulation does apply to students who are enrolled in physical activity courses, but I do not feel that it should apply to faculty members. We are instructing the boys in the towel room to honor the towel tickets presented by the faculty members.

As you doubtless know, our towel room service is dependent upon this fee paid by the students each semester. In most cases their towel tickets are used up by the end of the semester. I am enclosing the sheet of instructions that is given to each towel room employee.
