Dear Dean Smith:

Henry Shenk and I had a talk Friday, and again this morning regarding the possible enforcement of required Physical Education for the students here at the University next year. I tried to call you Friday morning and again Friday afternoon for a conference.

I am hoping that if and when you should decide on a convenient time to meet that Henry Shenk and I can meet with you and other authorities of the University and discuss the matter before it goes too far. The matter of personnel is quite a problem and it will take our best thinking to get this in operation at a required time.

After having talked to Dr. Cora Downs and the Chancellor regarding the location of the "Kansas Tougheer", we are preparing to put the first one up south of the gymnasium between the women's tennis courts and the handball courts. We will put one up there first and see how it goes before we attempt the second one which is to be west of the varsity tennis courts just south of the stadium and in a grove of trees bordering the golf course. If you are interested I would be glad to go over these locations and discuss the projects further.
