Nearly two-thirds of these 3695 elementary school teachers (Table I) were on an eight months salary basis and were teaching in one-teacher schools. Their typical (median) salary per month was \$87.50, but nearly fourteen per cent of them were paid less than \$75.00 per month and ninety-six teachers did not receive as much as \$65.00 per month.

In the two-or-more teacher schools the typical monthly salary was approximately a hundred dollars (\$99.75), on a nine months basis. Relatively few in either of these groups were paid as much as \$150.00 per month. As a consequence of these facts it is not difficult to believe that the educational opportunity of pupils in these elementary schools must be seriously curtailed.
