In tabulating the monthly salaries of high school teachers (Table II) these cities of third class and consolidated districts were grouped together but separately from the rural high schools. The median salary in the latter schools (\$138.00) is higher than in the former group of schools (\$131.00), as has been true rather consistently in the past.

Salary data were available for only a relatively small number of high schools in cities of the second class and of community high schools in cities of the second class and of community high schools. Due to the limited number, no tabulation is presented here. It appeared that the median salary would be somewhat higher than in the rural high schools.
