I have received a letter from Dean Schwegler advising me that the committee on the Administration of the University Teachers' Diploma sympathetically considered my recommendation that you be allowed to do your practice teaching this fall, but the committee felt that in view of the fact that it was rigidly insisting on the scholastic requirements in all other departments common fairness demanded that the same standards be asked for in physical education which are currently observed by other departments of the University.

In my opinion, it would be wise to take the attitude of the committee rather seriously, as they insist upon certain standards for practice teaching.
